Anna Russian (OP)	Pink oxheart w/ orange shoulders, heavy producer of variable-sized meaty fruits. Excellent acidic tomato flavor, great for sauces. Disease-resistant foliage. Excellent trellised on a metal fence with 4" grid. Too wispy to cage. 4' tall.	Pink	Semi	70-75	TG
Black from Tula (OP)	Rose brown with green shoulders, this very beautiful and very delicious Russian heirloom is highly productive. One of our favorites.	Black	Indet	80	TG
Black Pear (OP)	Beautiful dark brown pear-shaped medium-sized tomatoes with excellent, rich taste, great acid-sugar balance. Healthy potato-leafed plants produce abundantly.	Black	Semi	80	TG
Black Sea Man (OP)	Good producer of beautiful, med-size, reddish brown flattened fruit w/ green shoulders & exquisite flavor. Short shelf life due to tender skin. Blossom end zippered. Taste test winner!	Black	Det	80	M

High Density Tomato Growing

Too many tomatoes to choose from? Can't make up your mind? Consider High Density Tomato Growing, a great technique for anyone who wants to try lots and lots of varieties. The idea is to plant two different tomato plants together in a single cage. In our research gardens we have tried several different combinations. The results? They worked beautifully. The plants were healthy, dense, lush, and productive. We got fewer tomatoes off of each individual plant, of course, but about the same total production per cage.

We suggest choosing plants of similar size and vigor. If one of them seems to be outgrowing the other, you can prune off a few branches of the vigorous one to give the weaker plant a chance to catch up. Choosing tomatoes of different sizes, shapes, and colors will make it easy to distinguish them. This can give decorative effect as well, such as combining red and yellow cherry tomatoes.

If you give High Density Tomato Growing a try, let us know how it works for you. We'd love to hear about your experiences.

Definitions and Symbols Key

Tomato Types

Classic – Generally round & smooth, ranging from medium-small to medium-large in size. Sometimes called main crop or slicing tomatoes.

Beefsteak – Generally large to very large, usually somewhat irregular in shape, often later to mature.

Paste – Generally elongated shapes and often meatier with less seed gel, hence good for processing as sauce & paste.

Cherry – Small, bite-size tomatoes.

Growth Habits

Det – Determinate. The plant grows to a certain point, then stops and sets fruit which ripen in a short, concentrated harvest. Height is often 4' or less.

Indet – Indeterminate. Also called vining tomatoes, the plant grows continuously until it dies, continuing to flower & set tomatoes until the end. Can get quite large, at least 5', often more.

Semi – Semi-indeterminate. Larger than determinate but not as large as indeterminate. About 4'.

DwInd. – Dwarf indeterminate. Short & bushy like determinates, but keep producing indefinitely like indeterminates. A new category.

Seed Types

OP – Open-pollinated. Seeds from open-pollinated varieties can be saved because they will produce plants and fruit that are identical to their parent. All heirlooms are OP.

Hybrid – Seeds cannot be saved because they will not come true. Hybrid seeds can only be bought from a seed company who produces it by crossing particular parent plants..

Heirloom – Always open-pollinated, therefore seeds can be saved. Heirlooms have generally been saved and passed on by generation after generation in some family or community who would select the best plants to save seeds from.

Key to disease resistance and/or tolerance

V – Verticillium wilt tolerance

F1 – Fusarium wilt (race 1) tolerance

F2 – Fusarium wilt (race 2) tolerance

FF – Fusarium wilt (race 1& 2) tolerance

N – Nematodes tolerance

St – Stemphyllium tolerance

A – Alternaria stem canker tolerance

T – Tobacco mosaic virus tolerance

Note: Only hybrids list disease resistance because seed companies pay to have the seed tested and certified. Heirlooms may well be resistant also.
